WHO ARE WE?



Established in 2016, **Guzarish** is a Non Government Organization (NGO), registered as a trust under the Indian Trusts Act.

Guzarish's flagship project 'Books For All' - focuses on bridging the gap between people who have excess of books and those who need books.



Books for All was started by Ankit Manchanda and three of his friends — Jaibeer Singh, Prachi Luthra and Sanymi Gupta (the 3 being Teach For India Fellows) in 2016. During their tenure as TFI fellows, they observed that greater learning outcomes can be provided in government schools with supplementary reading material for a holistic development of children.

WHAT DO WE DO?



THE PROBLEM

According to a research, more than 2 million kids in India cannot afford a book to read. On the other hand, there are privileged people who have piles of books lying on their shelves – which are sold as scrap (raddi).

THE SOLUTION

We, at Books For All aim to bridge this gap by offering FREE DOORSTEP PICK UP for collecting books from individuals/ schools/ corporates, etc and distributing them to underprivileged kids across the country, ensuring that every kid has access to books.

HOW WE OPERATE

COLLECT

We reach out to donors and collect books, also offering

Free Doorstep Pick-up.

CATEGORIZE

The books are then brought to the warehouse cum library— The Book House, and sorted into different categories

DISTRIBUTE

We distribute the donated books to credible NGOs and organise **book fairs in Govt schools**

IMPACT ASSESMENT

We assess the impact by sharing the **book reviews** written by kids to ensure donors that their books are being used







OUR IMPACT





We further aim to distribute **1,50,000 books** in the year 2021.

Awarded 'NGO Leadership Award' by World CSR Day and World Sustainability.

OUR BENEFICIARIES

NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANISATIONS

- Providing books to NGOs working in the education sector, at a minimal cost of ₹10/15/20.
- Partnering with NGOs in both ways - where either they procure books from us, or donate books to us.
- Reaching out to a greater number of students across the country.

GOVERNMENT SCHOOL STUDENTS

- Supplementary materials that help students in their regular school studies.
- English/Hindi novels to inculcate the habit of reading in kids.
- Reference and guide books to help students prepare for entrance exams.
- All books available at a minimal cost of ₹15/20.

OUR BENEFICIARIES: NGOs



Our partnership with **Goonj** has helped us to ensure a continued access to books to children.





BFA itself has a target to establish 20 Libraries this year. Past month we have come up with 3 libraries in Delhi already and have plan to establish 5 in different parts of Uttrakhand.



We have provided books to NGOs across the country; from Ladakh to Chennai, & from Manipur to Maharashtra
